



Notice to Players:

We continue to monitor the CDC (Centers for Disease Control) and WHO (World Health Organization) guidance related to the COVID-19 (Corona Virus). Please know that we take this pandemic very serious and the health of our associates and guests is our top priority.

Along with general safety practices: promoting thorough hand washing, encouraging associates to stay home if they are sick, we have also implemented the following additional safety precautions as we navigate through this difficult time:

- Customers are able to book online with an option to prepay.
- Doors will remain open during business hours.
- Social Distancing: 6 feet of separation
- Hand Sanitizer is available throughout the facility.
- Clubhouse is open at 50% capacity.
- The Restaurant is open for dining. Tables are spread out 6 feet apart.
- We ask that our guests do not congregate with more than their foursome.
- Golf carts (steering wheel, seats, armrest) will be sanitized before and after each round.
- All doors, counter tops, and other surfaces will be disinfected on a more aggressive routine basis.
- Credit or Debit Card transactions are preferred.
- Card Swiper will be placed on counter. Guests are to swipe their own card.

We will also be taking the following precautionary measures on the golf course:

- No Putting Green Flagsticks
- Practice Balls will be in pyramids on the Driving Range
- No Ballwashers, Bunker Rakes, or Water Coolers
- Players are to leave Flagsticks in at all times
- Walking is encouraged both for social distancing and exercise.

Please keep in mind that the golf course is spread out over 500 acres of land, so once you are on the golf course there is plenty of fresh air. We ask both our associates and guests if you are not feeling well, please stay home. We understand this is a fluid situation and we appreciate the collective efforts of our associates and guests.
